The Pulpits Are Silent

Trouble is ahead.

Time is short.

What incredible times we live in—like no previous generation. The world is heading pell-mell for a conclusion though nobody knows the timing on this. But we are privileged to look at signs that are like clouds forming on the horizon. In the 1970s there were only a few events happening that were prophecy-related. There were minor shakings but sometimes connecting the dots was even a stretch!

Fast forward to today and there are so many prophecy-related events happening daily and hourly that it presents a major dilemma

for those of us watching the signs of the times to know just where to focus. As I post stories daily on my website, I agonize that I must leave off so many as space and time

won't allow readers to zero in on all that is happening!

It is a privilege and a challenge to be born for such a time as this. Very little that is predicted to happen in the "last days" is good news and who wants a steady dose of bad? But if one can "look up" one can bear the heartache of looking around as the signs of the times explode on our news outlets.

The Bible asks us to be "watchmen" (Ezekiel 33). We're to be sounding an alarm. Trouble is ahead. Time is short. And I have never felt such a sense of urgency and the realization that time is short.

I am watching signs "converge." They are stunning and breathtaking. But most pastors will not talk about them!

LifeWay Research is a Nashville-based, evangelical research firm that specializes in surveys about faith in culture and matters that affect the church. They report that a third of America's Protestant pastors expect Christians to be raptured—or taken up in the sky to meet Jesus—as the last of the last days begin. Over 36% believe in a pre-

Tribulation Rapture. In spite of this glorious good news, their pulpits are silent.

Over 50% of Protestant pastors, according to the survey, believe in a literal Antichrist—but their pulpits are silent.

Most pastors hold to the basic teachings of Christ's Second Coming—but their pulpits are silent.

This same survey says almost 50% of Protestant pastors believe in a coming Millennium and hold to premillennialism. At this time we finally do away with the curse

and fallen human nature—but their pulpits are silent.

Pastor Tom Hughes leads an evangelical church in San Jacinto, California. He has written a thoughtful article

titled, "Five Reasons Pastors Don't Teach Bible Prophecy." He writes, "Prophecy fills the Bible. End time prophecy touches every person alive today. Jesus taught on it. So did John, Paul, Peter, James, and Jude. Yet only a small percentage of churches teach this crucial part of God's message to our generation.

"Some pastors don't teach it for theological reasons. They don't believe it, don't think it applies to us, consider it symbolic, or whatever. Others believe we're probably living near the end of the age, but still refuse to touch the topic. They see it as an elective part of God's curriculum. Take it or leave it."

Hughes continues, "That's not how Jesus saw it. He reprimanded the Pharisees and Sadducees for not discerning the times. 'When it is evening you say, it will be fair weather, for the sky is red; and in the morning, it will be foul weather today, for the sky is red and threatening. Hypocrites! You know how to discern the face of the sky, but you cannot discern the signs of the times.' " (Matthew 16:2-3 NKJV)

Hughes concludes, "More than a quarter of the Bible is prophecy—much of it yet to be fulfilled. How can we give congregations a well-rounded understanding of scripture if we leave out such a vital part of it?"

He then goes on to list these five reasons pastors may not be sharing these issues in the pulpit:

- They simply don't understand it. Maybe you serve as a pastor and you believe we live near the time of Christ's return, but you don't feel qualified to teach on such a large subject. Ask yourself this. Who qualified you to teach the Bible at all? The Lord did. His calling is His equipping. If He called you to be a pastor, He will equip you to teach all of the Bible.
- They fear offending members of the congregation. In today's church, pastors often feel more like referees than teachers. People find offense in so many things and the pastor becomes gun-shy. Maybe without realizing it, he begins to preach in ways he thinks will be least likely to offend. Other pastors see preaching as a means of getting people to feel good.
- They sense people will be scared. Bible prophecy can be unnerving. Hollywood makes money scaring people, so it loves to use apocalyptic themes. The truth can be scary. But isn't it better to be scared and prepared, than happy and condemned? For those who know the Lord, understanding the end times helps us to be faithful instead of fearful.

- People might not tithe if they think we're close to the end. But seeing prophecy fulfilled in our time reminds us that the end will come, and may be coming soon. A reminder of His soon coming is a reminder to invest in eternity, and stop trying to build on that which will pass away.
- There could be a fear of looking like the "loony-tune fringe." False and unbiblical teachers of prophecy abound. They're on the radio, on television, on the internet! But these are not reasons to avoid teaching prophecy. Errors, exaggerations, and charlatans are among the best reasons for teaching the real thing.

The prophecies of the first coming of Christ were fulfilled. They stand as evidence that the Bible can be trusted. Prophecies of His second coming work the same way, except we get to witness these events in our time, often with our own eyes.

The nations of the world seem moved, as though by a hidden hand, into exactly the right positions on a global chess board. What an amazing thing to see it happening before our eyes! It builds faith and draws our attention God-ward. And it is a fantastic evangelism tool.

So pastors, please don't be silent. Take a stand for God's eschatological truth! The King is coming. Tell the world about it.

Worse Than Canada's Week in Hell

NOTE FROM JAN: Since I live in Minneapolis, most of us were breathing smoke in early May thanks to the fires in Alberta—over 1,000 miles away. So severe were they that some of us hesitated to open our windows that week. Imagine the trauma at ground zero in Alberta, Canada. Daymond Duck of Prophecy Plus Ministries, authored the following article that resonated with me. I trust you'll ponder his sobering words. He is my guest columnist for this issue of our newsletter. The article is used with permission.

There is no question in the mind of this writer and many evangelical Biblebelieving Christians that Israel is a special nation. God clearly made an everlasting covenant to be the God of Abraham and his descendants in their generations, to give them all (not part) of the land of Canaan for an everlasting possession, and to be their God (Genesis 17:7-8).

As the great Dr. J. Vernon McGee said, "God did not give them a ninety-nine-year lease on the land. God gave them an everlasting possession" (Through the Bible with J. Vernon McGee, Volume I, page 74).

There is also no question in the mind of this writer and many evangelical Biblebelieving Christians that as the Tribulation period approaches, those nations that harm Israel will suffer similar harm. God clearly said "Your reward shall return upon your own head" (Obadiah 1:15).

There is no doubt that Canada is a great nation with millions of Christians and perhaps as many as 400,000 Jews. For the most part, the Jews have been safe, well-treated, prospered, and the Jewish population has grown.

Canada's 22nd Prime Minister (February 6, 2006 - November 4, 2015) was Stephen Harper, one of the best friends Israel had in the world during his time in office. He opposed President Obama's deal to let Iran eventually get nuclear weapons, closed Canada's Embassy in Tehran and spoke

well of Israel's Prime Minister Netanyahu.

When Prime Minister Harper visited Israel in 2014, Prime Minister Netanyahu called him "a great friend of Israel and the Jewish people." He was praised for his great moral leadership and his stance on anti-Semitism.

Mr. Netanyahu told Mr. Harper, "The people of Israel and I deeply appreciate your friendship, and the friendship of the people of Canada to us." Israel honored him by letting him be the first and only Canadian Prime Minister to ever address the Israeli Knesset (Parliament).

In 2015, things began to change. Justin Trudeau, son of former Prime Minister Pierre Trudeau, ran against Mr. Harper. The young Trudeau sought the Muslim vote; accused Mr. Harper of pandering to the Jews; criticized Mr. Harper's opposition to President Obama's deal to let Iran eventually get nuclear weapons; criticized Mr. Harper's closing of Canada's Embassy in Tehran; had some harsh words for Prime Minister Netanyahu's actions on settlement issues.

Mr. Trudeau won the election and was sworn in on Nov. 4, 2015. He moved Canada closer to the Muslims and widened the space between Canada and Israel.

On Jan. 24, 2016, following support for the two state solution by his Foreign Affairs Minister, Stephane Deon, Mr. Trudeau's government was widely accused of abandoning Israel. There is no other way to put it when his handpicked Foreign Affairs Minister is in favor of driving Jews out of their houses and off their land.

But to make matters worse, three days later, Mr. Trudeau released his official statement commemorating *International Holocaust Remembrance Day.* In that official document, Mr. Trudeau didn't even mention the suffering of the Jews. *It was almost like their suffering didn't matter and they didn't even exist in his mind.*

Adolf Hitler built concentration camps with gas chambers and furnaces. He gassed, burned, tortured and starved about six million Jews. He burned about 340 a day at Auschwitz I and more at Auschwitz II and his other newly-built crematoriums.

Yes, Adolf Hitler set fire to hundreds of thousands of Jewish men, women and children, and Justin Trudeau issued a statement to remember the event, but he

didn't mention the slaughter of even one Jew.

Following the release of bland his commemorative document, Canada had several weeks of unusually hot and dry weather. Then, on May 3, 2016, a wildfire

called "The Beast" broke out at Fort McMurray, Canada. A strong wind was gusting and about 88,000 people were told to immediately leave their houses and land.

At the time of this writing, hundreds of buildings have burned, thousands of Canadians are stranded, thousands say they have spent a week in hell (thankfully no one has burned to death), and the raging

fire has moved north to Saskatchewan.

I don't know why God allowed the unusually hot, dry gusty weather that Canada has had, the scorching wildfire, and Fort McMurray's week in hell. But I do know that anti-Semitism will be costly as the Tribulation period draws near.

I am wondering if this is a warning from God that has come upon the Canadian people

> because of Mr. Trudeau's anti-Semitism. am wondering God reminding Trudeau Mr. that burnina men, women and children to death is horrible even when those women men. children



are Jews instead of Canadians.

I am wondering if Canadians have been driven out of their houses and off their land because Mr. Trudeau is in favor of driving Jews out of their houses and off their land.

The pictures from Fort McMurray have been called pictures of Armageddon. The pictures from the Holocaust are, frankly, much worse.

The Days of Noah

President Obama's edict requiring all public schools to open girls' bathrooms, showers and other facilities to males who self-identify as female will lead to sexual chaos and confusion among children, critics predict. They suggest the ultimate goal and agenda of the Left is to wipe out all morality.

Many suggest that next on the agenda is to legalize and sanction pedophilia. There has been a longstanding effort on the part of pedophiles to normalize their deviancy – even renaming themselves "minor-attracted persons."

Left Turns

Part of our end-time delusion is thinking that far Left politics and evangelicalism can blend. They are attempting to do so in the annual "Justice Conference" sponsored by *World Relief*.

I have watched evangelicalism morph and decline for decades. I wasn't around to see the Mainline Protestants make a sharp left turn one hundred years ago. They traded salvation issues for social issues. The results have been devastating and their numbers have been plummeting.

Tooley A LJUSTICE As Mark Institute οf the Religion and for Democracy writes, "It was a long road for the Mainline Protestants. But that road began with theological

compromises early in the 20th century or before, when the Bible and Christian tradition were reinterpreted into metaphors, and the redemption story for lost souls was replaced by social reform under the banner of the social gospel."

On June 3-4, young people "let justice roll" in Chicago. The promotion material quoted Nelson Mandela, a hardened

Marxist with no Christian agenda. Some of the featured speakers are light years away from anything evangelical. This year Father Pfleger made an appearance. He was a part of Jeremiah Wright's Marxist outreach in Chicago. What does this have to do with the gospel?

Chelsen Vicari is an insightful Millennial who gets it. She writes, "This ostensibly evangelical conference seems to be a repackaged version of liberal Mainline Protestantism for hipsters. Over the years, organizers for the 'Justice Conference' have

carefully avoided addressing relevant cultural and social issues such as the persecution of Christians abroad, religious freedom, sanctity of unborn life, sexual ethics,

or support of Israel. Instead, speakers cover topics including racism, gun control, neo-pacifism, Liberation Theology, and denouncing American patriotism as bigoted idolatry."

Vicari continues, "Keep in mind, the 'Justice Conference' is not marketed towards progressive Christians. It's geared

towards young evangelical member denominations with big hearts for the poor and marginalized. So it's odd that many of the conference's keynote speakers and topics don't reflect their target audience's theological backgrounds."

Vicari says, "The temptation, however, is to address social gospel injustices through a divisive secular lens rather than a gospel-centered lens. 'Justice Conference' speakers must acknowledge human depravity that is at the center of social injustice. No government regime or political utopia on earth can ever fully extinguish inequality and injustice because they cannot extinguish sin. Only the blood of Jesus can do that. The leftward drift of the 'Justice Conference' will do little to aid the marginalized if organizers prioritize politics over the gospel."

She concludes, "Repentance. Forgiveness. Redemption. These topics also need mention when we dialogue about social justice. If not, then we evangelicals will follow the declining trajectory of the liberal Mainlines."

The founders of the modern evangelical movement met in the early 1940s as WWII was raging. They were watching liberalism implode because of their unbiblical agenda and they wanted to organize an effort to keep evangelicals on track. And they did for decades. But slowly evangelical outfits began to make left turns.

They took up campaigns on behalf of global warming, ridding America of her nukes, and eliminating poverty. Many evangelicals are in favor of America ridding herself of nuclear weapons. This is the same old Leftist delusion that North Korea.

Russia, and Iran, will co-operate and lay down their nukes. And what have nukes got to do with the gospel?

This same "Justice Conference" featured neo-Marxist Cornell West in 2015. He tried to shame the young evangelical crowd about their "white supremacy problem." Organizers of the conference felt West could awaken attendees to police brutality issues.

Other speakers have suggested that the "raw power of government" be unleashed. This is nothing but far left politics being rammed down the throats of impressionable young people. How will this minister to their souls?

Evangelicalism will go down in flames in the same manner the Mainline denominations have over the last 100 years.

If you are a part of an evangelical church, won't you speak up and defend the goal of the founders of this movement? Won't you appeal, in fact, plead, that there be a return to gospel-centered preaching with a salvation emphasis rather than social justice causes that make not a whit of difference for eternity?

The idea that "Black Liberation Theology" is overshadowing salvation issues should make every evangelical take some kind of action. The focus needs to be first on deliverance from sin rather than an emphasis on deliverance from poverty.

One has to wonder if the goal of the "Justice Conference" is to turn Millennial young people into good little socialists.

How tragic. And how unbiblical.




