The King Is Still Coming— Even If It's Unpopular!

My family has roots in the Iron Range in Minnesota, and I am actually a relative of another former resident, Bob Dylan, who as far as I know, remains a believer in Jesus. Many of his songs are legends now. But his classic song contains this accurate message: The times they are changing.

Sometime in the last 25 – 30 years, the church took its attention off of the incredible message that the King is coming. The days are gone when to be an evangelical Christian was nearly synonymous with being pro-Israel and pro-prophecy. It's a new day and not a happy one, and this ministry has heard from hundreds of you affirming this.

Dispensationalism Decline

Eschatology and pro-Israel sentiment have always found a home within Dispensationalism. This teaches a literal rapture, tribulation, Millennium, and separate role for Israel and the church.

Twentieth Century teachers John Walvoord, Dwight Pentecost, Tim LaHaye, Hal Lindsey, Chuck Missler, Mark Hitchcock, Ron Rhodes, Dave Reagan, Thomas Ice, Ed Hindson, and many more, have educated millions. I'm just one of many

who have learned from these scholars. Since 2001, I have featured many of them on air and at conferences.

Jim Showers is President of an organization I love and respect, *Friends of Israel Gospel Ministry*. He states, "The next generation of ministry leaders, at best, sees no value in studying future prophecy and, at worst, views it with disfavor or as something to be avoided entirely."

He suggests even those who hold to Dispensationalism and a Christian Zionist view of Israel, borne out of a literal interpretation of the Bible, are distancing themselves from these topics.

The Church Yawns and Not Yearns

At a time in history when headlines are, at best, maddening and bleak, the very theologies that make sense of them are declining in favor of theologies that fill pews and increase donations. As I like to say—and say it often, sadly—I never thought I would see the day.

What incredible times we live in—like no previous generation. The world is heading pell-mell for a conclusion, and today there is a classic yawn within the church. The hoofbeats of the Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse are heard faintly in the distance

and they are fading out, not rushing in.

It is a privilege and a challenge to be born for such a time as this. Very little that is predicted to happen in the “last days” is good news, and who wants a steady dose of bad? But if one can “look up”, one can bear the heartache of looking around as the signs of the times explode on our news outlets.

Convergence!

The Bible asks us to be “watchmen” (Ezekiel 33). We’re to be sounding an alarm. Trouble is ahead. Time is short. And I have never felt such a sense of urgency as it concerns this message.

I am watching signs “converge.” They are stunning and breathtaking. But most pastors will not talk about them!

Jesus reprimanded the Pharisees and Sadducees for not discerning the times. “When it is evening you say, it will be fair weather, for the sky is red; and in the morning, it will be foul weather today, for the sky is red and threatening. Hypocrites! You know how to discern the face of the sky, but you cannot discern the signs of the times.” (Matthew 16:2-3 NKJV)

But if you wish to be silent, pastors and teachers, you are marginalizing up to one-third of the Bible. Would a church leader marginalize this much of the Bible on other relevant key topics? I doubt it!

The Open Door Has Closed

When I began Olive Tree Ministries years ago, I ministered in hundreds of churches, home fellowships, women’s groups, and even some men’s groups. Every week I

would pile in my vehicle with a 12-string guitar, sound and audio-visual equipment, books, newsletters, and head toward destinations large and small.

My audiences were enthusiastic as I shared messages focusing on Bible prophecy, Israel, Israel in prophecy, Christ in the Passover, Jewish evangelism, and current events. This spanned almost all church denominations. Now and then, even a Catholic fellowship invited me.

Today, about 90% of open doors have simply closed. It is not just indifference—it is outright hostility towards topics that a few years ago generated great enthusiasm. Yes, there are small pockets of interest that remain made up of remnant believers, but opportunities are not what they used to be.

Thankfully, enthusiastic students of eschatology now have the vast Internet from which to learn—as long as they can discern the credible from false teachers! The latter abound, offering sensationalism!

Mocking and Anti-Israel Today

We are now in the days of 2 Peter 3:3: The mocking and scoffing generation as to end-time events. We are in a time when Israel has been so maligned that even within evangelicalism, she is seen as an “apartheid occupier” more than a special, called-out people.

Anti-Israel sentiment is global. Antisemitism is raging. Entire denominations are engaging in the Boycott, Divest, Sanction Movement that harms Israel economically. At the same time, there are so many prophecy-related events happening daily

and hourly that it presents a major dilemma for those of us watching the signs of the times to know just where to focus.

I am told such topics will scare people. That Bible prophecy will marginalize church giving. That it may offend. That it is not politically correct. That it will even make the teacher look like he or she represents “the fringe”—whatever that means!

Please, Sound the Alarm!

If you believe that the King is coming any day, do not be silent. Keep sounding the alarm. Yes, it will cost you something. But your rewards are eternal. The prophecies of the first coming of Christ were fulfilled. They stand as evidence that the Bible can be trusted. Prophecies of His second coming work the same way, except we get to witness these events in our time, often with our own eyes.

The nations of the world seem moved, as though by a hidden hand, into exactly the right positions on a global chess board. What an amazing thing to see it happening before our eyes!

I hope you're excited about it! And I hope your pulpit is proclaiming it!

in Zion!**

*for the day of the
Lord is coming.*

Have you been begging God to blow the trumpet? Have you been begging God to do something different? Have you been begging God to take you to be with Him in His presence, face-to-face?

It does not take much looking around to notice that the days are growing darker and that evil is waxing worse and worse. It is blatantly apparent to those, even with little experience in the scriptures, that our world is lost, broken, and trending toward the Tribulation.

Jesus told his disciples on the Mount of Olives in Matthew 24, that in the last days before His return, many false prophets would arise, lawlessness would increase, and the love of many would grow cold. We are seeing these very words come to life. It is no wonder, then, that you and I are both

In Mark 5, we are introduced to a man desperately in need of help from his creator. He lives among the tombs, he cries out night and day, he cuts himself with stones. As Jesus' boat slides ashore, this man meets him and cries out with a loud voice.

“What have you to do with me, Jesus, Son of the most high God? I adjure you by God, do not torment me.”

Not only was this man in dismal shape physically, but we know he was also in dismal shape spiritually.

A Legion of Demons

As you read on in the account, we are told that he was full of a legion of demons. A Roman Legion contained up to 600 soldiers. The word legion is used purposefully. This man was full of demons.

Jesus is moved with deep compassion and is compelled to act. He commands the demons to be removed from the man. As we know, they did not want to leave the region, so Jesus cast them into a herd of pigs. Because the demonic prerogative is destruction, the demons compel the pigs to their ruin as they run into the sea.

The man in desperate need of help, physically and spiritually, is now sitting quietly in his right mind and clothed. He was transformed from the inside out by the words of Christ Jesus. I imagine him there, radiant with thanksgiving and healed, wounds gone and mind right.

Tell Them How Much the Lord Has Done for You!

It is only natural for one who has been so greatly affected to want to be in the presence of the One who rescued and saved him from his bondage and brokenness. But Jesus had different plans for this man. He begs Jesus to let him into the boat so he could be with him from this day of transformation forward. Yet, Jesus tells him to stay in his home region and commands, “Go home to your friends and tell them how much the Lord has done for you and how he has had mercy on you.”

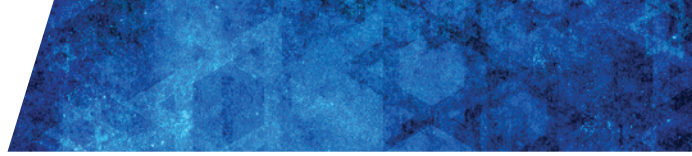
Eagerly Awaiting His Return

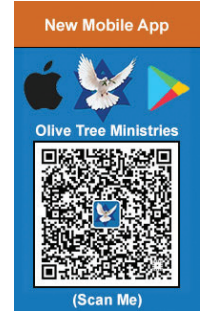
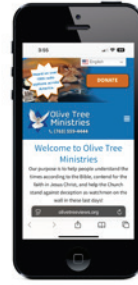
So, press on, keep speaking out, and keep looking up, because Jesus has not finished using you yet.

“Free Palestine” Means Death to Jews!

Twice in May, monsters attacked innocent Jews, driven by the Muslim mantra to “free Palestine.” Many are asking if these events, which were preceded by intensified anti-Israel and antisemitic activity worldwide, are a harbinger of things to come? Will such hate-driven activity, perpetrated by copy cats or just plain demented people, continue to proliferate?

Two young people, Yaron Lischinsky and Sarah Lynn Milgrim, were mercilessly gunned down on the streets of Washington, D.C. on May 22. The perpetrator was shouting the familiar jihad call already mentioned.

Yaron and Sarah were Jewish believers in Jesus the Messiah. They were staff members at the Israeli Embassy, and devoted

defenders of the Jewish state. According to *All Israel News*, Yaron’s faith in Jesus and trust in God’s Word only deepened his passion for the people and land of Israel.

Church—sit up and notice. Wake up. Yaron and Sarah were part of us, too.

Surviving Hitler but Not a Jihadist
Then on June 1, an illegal alien from

Egypt shouted the mantra once again—“Free Palestine”—and began a jihad attack against innocent Jews in Boulder, Colorado with fire. One of the eight Boulder victims is a Holocaust survivor. She survived Hitler, but she may not survive a monster jihadist 80 years later.

Boulder, Colorado, is the most left-wing city in a state that has swung hard left. It is simply a fact that antisemitism is most at home in places where the Left dominates.

In the immediate aftermath of the October 7th attack against Israel, before Israel had even gone into Gaza, virtually every major American city erupted with anti-Israel protests. Having been welcomed into the family of God, Gentile believers have a special calling. Not only are they invited to engage in the Jewish roots of their faith in the God of Israel, but they are also chosen to make Israel jealous for a deeper relationship with Him.

The Envy of the Islamic World

Let's be honest—the Palestinian people are free! Their lifestyle is the envy of fellow Arabs and Muslims throughout the repressive Islamic world. They had their own state. It was called Gaza. How did that work out? They let tyrants called Hamas rule and destroy their Palestinian state.

But now the entire world wants them to have another state called Palestine when the first opportunity proved to be a disaster.

Confidently Proclaiming the Word of God

41 pastors and wives attended our May Huddle in suburban Minneapolis taught by Trevor Rubenstein and David Tal.

The Pastor's Huddle was created after realizing there was a deep void in most modern theological education. Time and time again, Jan Markell and Pastor Mark Henry would have conversations with pastors who had little to no education in, or experience with, eschatology, the study of the last days.

This wore on their hearts to the point where they decided something needed to be done. Someone needed to step in and bring the study of eschatology to the forefront of the heart and mind of the shepherds of the flock. The Pastor's Huddle was started!! We have had outstanding teachers over the last 5 events, and each time we have seen significant growth in attendance.

Discovering Daniel and Revelation!

As a brief overview, our first Huddle covered the Book of Daniel. Dr. Mike Powell taught ten intensive hours on the theological and eschatological significance of the book of Daniel. The pastors were equipped to stand before their congregations and

proclaim, "This is what God said to his people through the life and book of Daniel the prophet." Many attending pastors came to me after the Huddle and expressed great gratitude for the teaching. The majority had never had such a deep dive into a prophetic book.

At this time, Jan and Mark realized the opportunity that stood before them. Immediately following the conclusion of the Huddle, the second opportunity began to be planned. Dr. Powell committed to teaching another intensive session to pastors, but this time on the Book of Revelation.

No Longer On An Island

Pastors were networking with each other and praying with and for one another. As I sat back and pondered what was being done, I was struck by the most significant unintended result of the Huddle: true and lasting friendships. Many of the pastors who came were alone, and they had felt as though they were on an island. They had no one who was like-minded around; they

had no theological allies in their battlefield, but now they had a group of men around the country to lean on and partner with.

Replacement Theology and Antisemitism: Who Can Understand It?

In the fall of 2024, Dr. Mike Dodds from Calvary University and Seminary in Kansas City, MO, equipped the attendees with *A Biblical and Theological Evaluation of Replacement Theology*. With antisemitism on the rise and a poor understanding of God's future promises to the Jewish people, we could not have had a timelier topic at the Huddle.

The pastors were given lectures, notes, and other resources to help them fight against the false teachings of Replacement Theology. They were prepared to stand on the Word of God and the faithful promises of the Father to His chosen people.

The Importance of God's Promises!

Just this last month, May 2025, we completed our most recent Huddle. We invited David Tal and Trevor Rubenstein to give the pastors *A Geo-Political History and a Biblical and Theological Assessment of the People of Israel*. The pastors again walked away full of understanding and driven to teach their churches and others the importance of God's promises to the Jewish people. Some were moved to tears of gratitude for the time they had at the most recent Huddle.

Coming in the Fall, 2025

We are currently planning another Huddle for October, 2025. As a team at *Olive Tree*

Ministries and *Mark Henry Ministries*, we are so thankful for your support and prayers as we continue to equip pastors to stand and proclaim faithfully, with confidence, the Word.

And the Bible says that today is the day of salvation (Acts 28).

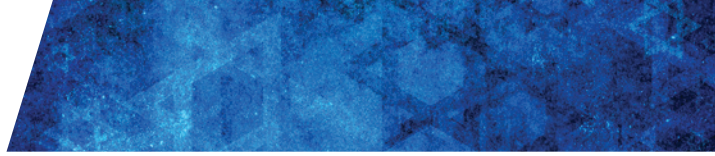
The Bible also says all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God (Rom. 3:23) and the wages of sin is death (Romans 6:23).

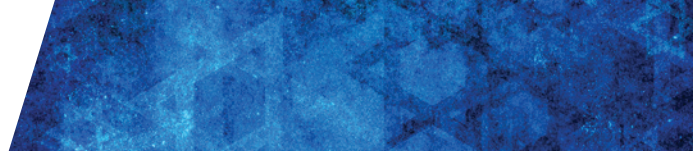

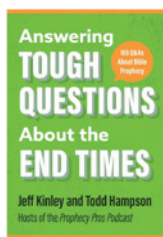

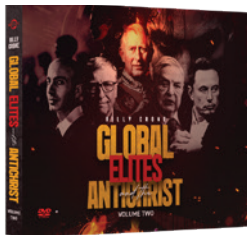
