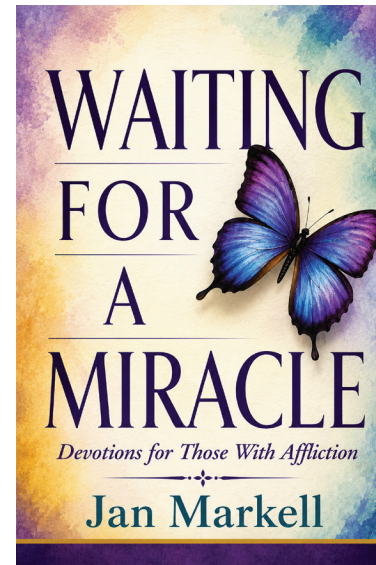
We hope to air these broadcasts twice a month.

Comfort My People

Comfort, comfort my people, says your God. Speak tenderly to Jerusalem, and cry to her that her warfare is ended, that her iniquity is pardoned, that she has received from the Lord's hand double for all her sins.—Isaiah 40:1

Scripture tells us to “Comfort my people” but what does comfort look like in a nation bearing the weight of constant war? After spending almost three years building relationships in Israel, we discovered that comfort begins with something surprisingly simple: being there, listening, and walking alongside people who are hurting.

Recently, a small Israeli Reserve unit went on a mission to Lebanon. Right before they left, Olive Tree—you—provided new uniforms for them, and they were so thankful. They made a video the morning they left thanking us for the uniforms, but we never got to see it. They were in a village in Lebanon when a terrorist, hiding in a church, opened fire. One of our soldiers was killed, and his death made national news. He was Major (res.) Itamar Sapir. Itamar is survived by his wife, Roea, and their one-year-old son. He was 27 years old.



War Is Hell

The people of Israel are hurting, perhaps more than ever before in modern times, and this pain is transforming the country. There is a current mental health crisis in Israel that is unprecedented. In the past, wars were shorter, but today's wars are prolonged. Then came October 7, 2023—a modern holocaust that cut to the heart of the nation. Can you imagine armed terrorists invading your small town and committing horrifying atrocities in the name of Allah?



(PTSD) Post Traumatic Stress Disorder is crippling the country.

This is an ever-present threat in Israel.

Israeli Health Ministry statistics show that the current mental health collapse is worse than anything Israel experienced in past wars (1973 Yom Kippur or 2006 Lebanon) due to a combination of extraordinary facts:

Depression, anxiety, addiction, and an epidemic of Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) are crippling the country. Trauma and grief add to what experts say is an “incredibly high” divorce rate in Israel.

Now is the time to “Comfort, comfort my people, says your God.” (Isaiah 40:1)



Returning to Israel!

The rockets are finally reduced in frequency and Jean DeJong and I will soon head back to Israel. Returning to the land brings excitement and sadness. It is wonderful to see our friends and to offer help and a measure of hope, and difficult to see the sadness of the people.

But God tells us we have something important to offer, something that will make a difference. “Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God.” (2 Cor. 1:4) God tells us there is purpose in suffering—we suffer so that we may be able to comfort others. He is compassionate—a God who comforts us and sends us to ease the pain of others.

What Is L'Chaim Israel?

L'Chaim means “To Life!” It is an expression that celebrates the joy of being alive. Many of you asked about what our new focus—*L'Chaim Israel*—is doing to help Israelis. Because of your love for Israel and your generosity, we’ve been able to bless Israel and offer comfort in countless ways—either directly or indirectly. Sometimes we come alongside existing ministries to be of support.

We share our faith in Yeshua (Jesus), which helps Israelis know you love them; support Messianic believers; build bomb shelters in some communities. Additionally, we help with security for two Israeli border farms and support an Israeli pro-life center.

Thanks to your generosity, we provide safety equipment to IDF Reserve Units: uniforms, helmets, bullet-proof vests, field ultrasound machines, and distribute grocery cards to soldiers and others in need.

We support an organization that trains Messianic youth in their faith as they enter the IDF. We’ve helped an organization that assists Ethiopian Jews acclimate to Israel. We’ve helped distribute Bibles and provided support for those engaged in Christ-centered biblical counselling.

Jews Face “The Greatest Threat Ever”

One of my favorite writers, Jonathan Brentner, states, “The steadily intensifying antisemitism of our day points to the reality of the rapidly-approaching Tribulation period. It's one of the more distinguishing signs of our time because it aligns with so many prophecies that predict hatred for Israel and the Jews during the last days.”

U.S. Democrats

Almost all members of the Democrat Party in Washington have turned on Israel. They have approved financial aid to Israel since 1950 and much more after 1973. In recent years, it has been \$3 billion a year—which they now wish to cancel. According to *Pew Research*, eight-out-of-ten Democrats view Israel unfavorably. Consider that as recently as 2015, most all Democrats were pro-Israel.

When the October 7 slaughter took place, Leftists decided that was the time to switch sides and cheer for the barbarians—not Israel!

The Jews Are On Everybody's List

Britain's most senior police officer warned that antisemitism has reached unprecedented levels, saying Jewish communities face their greatest threat to date as authorities confront a series of attacks and rising tensions. It is not uncommon today to hear people state that the Jew-hatred of the 21st Century is comparable to the hatred that led to near genocide of the Jews in the 1930s.

Mark Rowley, head of the Metropolitan Police, said British Jews are being targeted by a wide range of extremist actors, which he linked, in part, to the influence of social media. He states, “The ghastly fact is that *Jews are on everybody's list*, all of those hateful groups, whether you're extreme right, whether you're extreme left, whether you're Islamist terrorist, whether you're right-wing terrorist,” he told *The London Times*.

Bad Theology Leads to Anti-Semitism

Pastor Gary Hamrick of *Cornerstone Chapel* in Virginia writes, “In the year following the Oct. 7, 2023 attack on Israel by Hamas, over 10,000 antisemitic incidents were recorded in the U.S.—an increase of 140% over the previous year—and the most ever since the *Anti-Defamation League* began tracking antisemitic acts in 1979. On college campuses, in workplaces, among ‘influencers’ and politicians, even in some circles of the church, antisemitism is raising its ugly head.”



Hamrick continues, “We’re seeing pastors today who refuse to support Israel because they’ve been influenced by replacement theology’s faulty interpretation of Scripture, and there are terrible repercussions for giving place to this damaging theology. When the church entertains the idea that God has somehow replaced His covenant with the Jewish people, it provides fuel for the fire of those who would do Israel harm.”

And never forget that it was replacement theology that allowed many in Germany to go along with Hitler’s slaughter of the Jews.

Dark and Disturbing

The outstanding online Christian newspaper *Harbinger’s Daily* reports, “Once again, Canada has received a failing report card on its treatment of its Jewish community. The results were not only terrible—the findings were dark and disturbing.”



Canada: Crisis of Antisemitism

Writer Robert Gottselig of *Friends of Israel Gospel Ministry* in Canada, concluded in the *Harbinger’s Daily* article, “The report described Canada as facing a ‘national crisis of antisemitism.’”



“Fleeing” to Israel for Safety?

From 2021 to 2025, antisemitic incidents increased by 46% in Argentina, 60% in Canada, 64% in the United Kingdom, 124% in France, 131% in the United States, 215% in Germany, and 270% in Australia. *As the headline to this article states, this is the greatest threat to Jews ever because this time it is global.*

From Argentina to Australia, Jewish people across the globe report hiding their *Jewish identity* in public and questioning whether they have a future in their home countries. *And yes, God allows some of this calamity as it drives many of them home to Israel.* Indeed, tens of thousands are seeking safety in Israel.

The Urgency to Understand Bible Prophecy

Many prophetically-attuned believers pay attention to the nearness of Christ's call to the Church. Vast billions of people on earth, however, go down that broad way of this brief life without a thought of their swiftly approaching destiny.

Sadly, we know that most Christians—even though they might be born-again believers—pay no attention to the lateness of the hour as the end of the Age of Grace draws near. Much of this disregard (even though the Bible consists of more than 27% prophecy) is the fault of the people in the pews, who genuinely call Jesus Christ their Lord, but have little interest in personal Bible study.



The Silent Pulpit

At least an equal share of blame for not paying attention to the prophetic signs of the times must be placed with the pastors whose *flocks receive little or no teaching about biblical prophecy*, for which the stage is being set in every direction we look.

American Christians are caught up in not paying attention to the prophetic signals that burst in lightning-strike fashion from each news cycle, in reports from this nation and around the world.

What Is This World Coming To?

While these believers see the wars and rumors of wars, the economic strains and stresses that portend economic collapse and threaten to fracture their family well-being, or the absolute evil being perpetrated in the adulteration of a culture that murders millions of babies in the womb, they only shake their heads and wonder aloud something like, “*What’s the world coming to?*”

If they would just get into their Bibles—and if their pastors would get into God’s prophetic Word—the Holy Spirit would open their spiritual eyes to what this world is coming to. And what this world is heading toward is *God’s judgment and wrath*.

The Signals That Can’t Be Missed

I am of the conviction that God’s judgment and wrath can’t be too far distant. This is obvious to the Christian who’s familiar with God’s warning and alert to the flashing signals that can’t be missed. It is imperative that we make our fellow believers aware that they should be paying attention.

We must hold up God’s prophetic Word to pastors in Bible-believing churches and remind them that they are responsible for teaching and preaching Bible prophecy. They must do so today, without delay, because time is fleeting in this Church Age.

As We See the Day Approaching

We have in the book of Hebrews an exhortation, I believe, that transcends merely urging believers to gather in physical meeting places. Of course, this is indeed an important part of the exhortation.



But just as importantly, it means we are to come together as Christ's Body in understanding the times, especially as we see the time of Tribulation approaching: "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as we see the day approaching" (Hebrews 10:25).

The words "the day approaching" in this passage is a warning of the day when Christ will call the Church into the clouds of Glory, and the time of Daniel's seventieth week—the Tribulation era—will begin.

We must come together and speak of the coming judgment as a Church body, especially as we see the stage being set for prophetic fulfillment.



Well Done, Good and Faithful Servant

We must, therefore, make sure our brothers and sisters are on the same page. Of course, we know from the apathy and because of the many different views of Bible prophecy that this cannot and will not be achieved in total, but we must do what we can to try to make it happen.

Like you, I want to hear the words of our Lord when we see Him face-to-face in that moment of Rapture. And I want every Christian to hear those words also. There will be no greater reward than to hear them as we look into the all-knowing eyes of our Savior, Lord, and God: "Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy Lord" (Matthew 25: 23).

Opening The Door

to an Ideology That Revels in Chaos

Disastrous open border policies have wreaked havoc across Europe and Western nations. The globalist rhetoric that caused nations to open their doors in the name of "inclusion" and "acceptance" has had disastrous consequences—predominantly, and unsurprisingly, the undermining of national sovereignty.

Nations have allowed themselves to be flooded with countless Muslim immigrants, not to build a better life, but to spread an ideology that revels in chaos, violence, and reshaping the fabric of societies.

An Ideology Once Expelled from Nations

Islamic politicians, public figures, and protesters regularly express their disdain for the Judeo-Christian foundation of Western society. Far from being patriotic toward the nations they have been accepted into, Muslim ideology insists that wherever they set foot belongs to them, and demands an overhaul to be brought under the subjection of Islamic law—by any means necessary.

Many nations not only willfully ignore this reality, they also take "acceptance" a step further, adopting broad "Islamophobia" laws that have made Islam untouchable from public criticism.



Is the West Right to be Suspicious of Islam?

An Oxford Union debate addressing the question: “Is the West right to be suspicious of Islam?” recently went viral across social media. The debate became a public spectacle as participants were met by hordes of Muslim protesters outside, outraged by the topic that was chosen, uttering threats against those who entered.

Startlingly, Aisha Khan, a student arguing on behalf of Muslims during the debate, declared that her opponent, Tommy Robinson, should be grateful that the mob wasn’t allowed to harm him.

“There is a crowd outside rioting against you tonight, and without the protection and generosity of a Muslim Palestinian president and a largely South Asian executive committee, you would be quite literally cooked,” she insisted to loud applause.

The Head of Public Policy for the *Christian Legal Center*, Tim Dieppe, responded to the woman’s remarks: “This is an extraordinary statement. She seems to be boasting that Tommy’s life was in danger from Islamic protestors, whilst arguing that the West should not be suspicious of Islam! Furthermore, she essentially claims that were it not for the generosity of the Muslim students, Tommy would have been killed.

Grateful to Muslims for Allowing People to Live??

Is Tommy supposed to be grateful? Astonishingly, the audience applauded at this. What were they applauding? The generous support of Muslims in allowing Tommy to live? Or the fact that the crowd wanted him dead? Are we supposed to be grateful to Muslims for allowing people to live now? Is that why we should not be suspicious of Islam?”

In the United States, the popularity of Islamic politicians in the Democrat Party, like NYC Mayor Zohran Mamdani, is growing at an alarming rate, expanding the already dangerous level of anti-American, anti-Christian, and antisemitic rhetoric in the nation.

Rejecting Mass Muslim Immigration is Not Racist

Rejecting mass Muslim immigration is not “hateful” or “racist”—and it does



not run contrary to our desire as Christians for these individuals to be reached with the truth of the Gospel. Rejecting mass Muslim immigration is grounded in Biblical wisdom.

In the case of ancient Israel, God instructed them to be welcoming to strangers, with an important caveat: That the individuals they allow to live in their nation assimilate. That is a critical distinction. Why? Because accepting individuals with ideologies contrary—or actively opposed—to the moral foundation of a nation will inevitably reshape the culture.

Artificial Intelligence

Misquotes the Bible Up to 60% of the Time

Do you use AI for Bible study, insight, or even sermon prep? Well, in addition to all the other problems, according to the CEO of *YouVersion*, a popular Bible app, AI platforms misquote the Bible at least 15% of the time and up to 60%, depending on the AI model.

Many of these changes are minor—commas in the wrong place or minor word shifts—but this is the Word of God we're talking about. Even the details matter. Jesus made this clear when he said, "For truly, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the Law until all is accomplished." (Matthew 5:18)

As the *YouVersion* CEO said, "For Bible translation, every word and punctuation is meaningful to Scripture translation."

Good translators take each word, comma, and period seriously, doing their best to most accurately convey what God wrote for us in his Word. AI bots are certainly not doing that when they make their own "translations" as they misquote Scripture.

AI can be a useful tool, but it should never replace careful study of the Scriptures for yourself. Christians must understand that not only is AI imperfect and prone to just inventing things out of thin air, but it has a bias that is often reflected in the answers it gives.

Go to the actual Scriptures for spiritual discipleship, not an AI bot. Remember, it is programmed by fallible, sinful humans.
